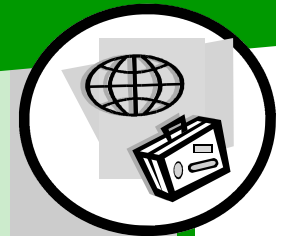

Programme

The three day event includes:

- Keynote speeches by acknowledged international experts addressing aspects related to the role of networking in sustainable tourism,
- Research paper presentations related to the conference theme and sustainable tourism in general,
- Sessions to develop an educational module, a wiki and a practical guide on networking for sustainable tourism,
- Industry Open Forum with regional industry, governmental and non-governmental representatives assisting in the development of case studies,
- Workshop to learn firsthand about challenges of and strategies for effective networking,
- Half Day Tour in the region combining sightseeing with networking activities,
- Time to socialize and network in the evenings including a welcome BBQ, Drinks over Vienna and a gala dinner at the town hall.

Think Tank Objectives

Committed to furthering the development and dissemination of knowledge in the field of sustainable tourism, BEST EN acknowledges the important role of networking in pursuing sustainability. Tangible outcomes of the Think Tank will include:

- a wiki exploring aspects related to the role of networking in the pursuit of sustainable tourism,
- a teaching module on networking for sustainable tourism for integration in undergraduate courses,
- a special edition of the Journal of Tourism and Hospitality Research featuring selected conference papers on the Think Tank theme,
- Case studies describing approaches to network for sustainable tourism,
- A practical networking guide for academia and industry.
